Call for Papers

The 9th International Conference on Digital Audio Effects, DAFx-06, will be held September 18-20, 2006, at McGill University, Montreal, Canada, organized by the Music Technology Area of the Schulich School of Music and CIRMMT (Center for Interdisciplinary Research on Music and Media Technology). DAFx grew from a very successful COST action in Europe and has established a reputation for the excellence of the papers and its open, friendly atmosphere. PAPER SUBMISSION

Authors of accepted papers are invited to submit their camera-ready paper before **June 30, 2006** according to one of the following two paper formats:

- Oral Presentation: maximum 6 pages in the Proceedings; about 20 minutes for presentation.
- Poster Presentation: maximum 4 pages in the Proceedings.

Submission is fully electronic and automated through the <u>Conference Web Submission System</u>. Paper archives must be prepared according to the <u>instructions</u> available on the <u>DAFx-06</u> web site (http://www.dafx.ca/dafx06 templates.html) and sent by **June 30, 2006**.

Final version of the accepted contributions will be published in the Conference Proceedings distributed to all registered delegates at the Conference site. After the Conference closure, the Proceedings will be published on the Internet (see previous conferences by browsing at http://www.dafx.de).
